LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)

- Beyond all boundary walls, fences and hedges.
- In, or on the clubhouse, car park, driveway and surrounding areas as defined by white posts and lines.
- On the practice ground to the left of the 14th hole as defined by white posts.
- To the right of the 16th hole as identified by white posts and only whilst playing the 16th hole.

NOTE: The field to the left of the 5th TEE is IN BOUNDS.

2. WATER HAZARDS (Rule 26)

- All Lateral Water Hazards are defined by red posts and lines.
- All Water Hazards are defined by yellow posts and lines.

3. STONES IN BUNKERS (Rule 24 - 1)

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.

4. OVERHEAD WIRES

If a ball strikes overhead cables or support poles at the 14th and 15th holes, the stroke must be replayed as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was played, in accordance with Rule 20 - 5 (Playing next stroke from where previous stroke played).

5. PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES

- identified by plastic sheaths and supports.
If such a tree, not within an area where play is prohibited, interferes with the player's stance

or the area of intended swing, the ball must be lifted without penalty and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24 - 2b(i) (Immovable Obstruction). The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.

6. GROUND UNDER REPAIR -

Play prohibited.

If a player's ball lies in a tree plantation defined by solid lines from which play is prohibited, or if such an area interferes with the player's stance or the area of intended swing the player must take relief under Rule 25 - 1.

7. FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS

All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24.2. In addition, if such an obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green of the hole being played

intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief without penalty as follows:

If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club-lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which a) is not nearer the hole, b) avoids such intervention and c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

8. WRONG PUTTING GREEN

For the purpose of Rule 25.3 the putting green of the 11th hole includes the apron surrounding the green.
